Mark 4:35 - 5:43

Division 1: His Followers desperately need to understand Jesus' true nature.	Division 2: Outsiders, living in desperate ignorance and sin, are claimed by Jesus.

Principle #1: Christ followers are Kingdom citizens by God's grace and need not fear anything in this world, because their king commands even the wind and the waves to obey Him.

Principle #2: Jesus seeks good soil in unlikely places and by His power brings a harvest creating insiders for his Kingdom, even in the midst of Satan's deceptive kingdom on earth.

Division 3: The insiders of Israel are desperately deceived; only by humbly seeking Jesus in faith will they be saved.	(for additional notes)
