Lesson 13: "In Jerusalem (O Jerusalem)"

Mark 11:1-26

Introduction

(Additional passages: Genesis 1:5; Leviticus 23:3; Romans 8:3-4; Exodus 12:3-6)

Division 1: Sunday 10 Nisan - the presentation of the Lamb of God.

Mark 11:1-11

(Additional passages: Malachi 3:1-3; 1 Corinthians 5:7; Psalm 118:22-27; Zechariah 9:9; Luke 19:41-42)

Principle #1: Don't be one of those rocks that "almost" cried out.

Division 2: Monday 11 Nisan - the fig tree symbolizing Israel is cursed.

Mark 11:12-19

(Additional Passages: Isaiah 56:6-7; 1 Kings 8:43)

Principle #2: God holds us responsible when He gives us resources to further His Kingdom. We are accountable to use those resources wisely.

Division 3: Tuesday 12 Nisan – the cursed fig tree that will never bear fruit is replaced.

Mark 11:20-26

(Additional Passages: Zechariah 4:6-7; Hebrews 6:19-20; Numbers 17:6-8)

Principle #3: Faith can accomplish what the Law could not.
