Division 1: God promised descendants to Abraham and God enabled Abraham to fulfill that promise.

Genesis 25:1-18 Genesis 17:17: 'Then Abraham fell on his face and laughed and said to himself, "Shall a child be born to a man who is a hundred years old? Shall Sarah, who is ninety years old, bear a child?" Genesis 23:1: "Sarah lived 127 years; these were the years of the life of Sarah." Genesis 22:17: "I will surely bless you, and I will surely multiply your offspring as the stars of heaven and as the sand that is on the seashore." Genesis 24:1: "Abraham was now very old, and the Lord had blessed him in every way."
