The Study of Revelation, 1 & 2 Thessalonians, and James Revelation 10:1-11:19; "The Mighty Angel and the Two Witnesses" DIVISIONS AND PRINCIPLES

Division 1: John sees a mighty angel and receives instructions and revelations concerning the 7th trumpet.

Revelation 10:1-11 (Additional citations: Revelation 9:12; Daniel 9:27; Matthew 24:21; 1 Corinthians 2:7; Deuteronomy 28-30; Ephesians 1:3-14; John 6:51; Romans 9:2)

Principle #1: You can live mortal life on the earth without consuming God's Word but you cannot spend a moment in eternity with Jesus without consuming God's Word.

Division 2: John is required to do measurements, hears about two coming witnesses, hears the 7th trumpet, and learns of its meaning.

Revelation 11:1-19 (Additional citations: Zechariah 2:1-13; Zechariah 13:9; 1 Corinthians 1:21; Revelation 13:5-7; Revelation 12:12; Matthew 21:21; Matthew 7:21; 1 John 4:6; Deuteronomy 30:6-7)

Principle #2: As we approach the end times, we must ignore signs and wonders as evidence of true Christianity unless they are performed by the two witnesses described in Revelation 11.
