<b>Division 1:</b> John describes the scene in Heaven immediately preceding the seven bowl judgments. Revelation 15:1-8 (Additional citations: 1 Peter 4:12; 1 Peter 1:7; Hebrews 6:1-20; Hebrews 10:35-36; James 1:3; Deuteronomy 32:41; Romans 12:14)
Principle #1: By believing in the sacrifice of the lamb and showing it by telling others about it in the face of persecution, we can have confidence in our salvation.

<b>Division 2:</b> John describes the first 5 bowl judgments and their effects. Revelation 16:1-11
Principle #2: God avenges His people as promised, but in so doing, carefully designs the punishment to cause loathing for the sinner's sin to encourage repentance.

<b>Division 3:</b> John cautions Believers and describes the final bowl judgments. Revelation 16:12-21
(Additional citations: Matthew 24:36-51; 1 Thessalonians 5:1-11; 1 John 1:8-9)
Principle #3: People with real faith are aware of Jesus' imminent return, live obediently and not as hypocrites.
