The Study of Revelation, 1 & 2 Thessalonians, and James

Revelation 22:1-21; "Come, Lord Jesus!"

DIVISIONS AND PRINCIPLES

Division 1: John completes the description of Eternal life for the saved. Revelation 22:1-5

(Additional passages: Matthew 5:6; John 7:38-39; Ezekiel 36:27; Psalm 1:1-3; Jeremiah 17:7-8; Isaiah 61:1-3; Galatians 5:22)

<u>Principle #1</u>: Life in the New Jerusalem will include Spirit-inspired righteousness, fruitfulness, divine intimacy, joy, and reigning forever.

Division 2: Jesus describes the effect of heeding His Words. Revelation 22:6-13 (Additional passages: Luke 12:35-48; 1 Corinthians 2:8)

<u>Principle #2</u>: Jesus will reward Believers who are heeding and spreading His Word when He comes, but punishes those who are not.

Division 3: Jesus describes the condition humans must meet for salvation and issues a last call.

Revelation 22:14-17

(Additional passages: Hebrews 9:14; Revelation 7:14; Romans 8:1 (KJV); Ephesians 1:13-14)

<u>Principle #3</u>: Believing Jesus' blood paid the penalty for our sins and demonstrating our faith by walking in the Spirit, gains us entry into the New Jerusalem.

Division 4: John gives warnings concerning the treatment of the Words in Revelation. Revelation 22:18-20

<u>Principle #4</u>: Adding to or subtracting from Revelation will result in eternal, divine punishment.
