1 Thessalonians 1:2-3

We give thanks to God always for all of you, constantly mentioning you in our prayers, remembering before our God and Father your work of <u>faith</u> and labor of <u>love</u> and steadfastness of <u>hope</u> in our Lord Jesus Christ.

Faith:

Principle #1: Faith means taking in God's Word from the Bible and then believing it in such a way that it changes our conduct.

Love:

Principle #2: Biblical love is self-sacrificing, shown by our actions, and is evidence of the Holy Spirit in us.

Hope:

Principle #3: Biblical hope is in eternal life in the New Jerusalem and is guaranteed by God for all who have Biblical faith expressed by Biblical love.
