2 Thessalonians 2:1 – 3:18

Divisions and Principles



=====

Division 1: Paul reminded everyone how to stand in the truth and face the future without fear.

2 Thessalonians 2:1-4

(Additional passage: Isaiah 14:14)

Principle #1: God’s Word shows us how to look for the true Christ and not be deceived.

=====

Division 2: Paul warned that anyone who does not stand in the truth is deceived and will be condemned.

2 Thessalonians 2:5-17

(Additional passages: 1 John 3:4; Romans 24-25; 2 Timothy 3:13; Genesis 3:5; 1 John 4:3; Revelation 19:20; Proverbs 5:22)

Principle #2: Anyone who persistently rejects the truth of God’s Word will one day be unable to believe it.

Division 3: Paul explained that they were accountable for their work and their relationships.

2 Thessalonians 3:1-18

(Additional passages: Hebrews 4:12; Mark 6:7; Proverbs 16:26; Galatians 6:1)

Principle #3: Believers are to hold one another accountable for the way they work and how they relate to each other.
