Divisions and Principles



=====

Division 1: James confronts us with tough words about life.

(Additional passage: James 1:1; James 2:17)

Principle #1: God wants us to receive his Word and remember it constantly, so that we will obey it faithfully no matter what happens in life.

Division 2: James tells us that it is time to grow up.

(Additional passages: James 2:14, 18, & 20; Ephesians 2:8, 9, & 10; Titus 3:8)

Principle #2: It is easy to say we have faith, but true faith is proven by our actions toward others, which is the fruit of our salvation.

Division 3: James tells us how to be spiritually mature.

(Additional passages: James 1:18; 1 Peter 1:23; Ephesians 2:8 & 9; Romans 10:17; James 1:22, 23, & 25)

Principle #3: The Spirit of God, through the Word of God, moves in us to love others and overcome our own selfishness, so that our faith and actions work together.
