## **Divisions and Principles**

**Division 1:** Carelessly teaching God's Word has the potential to condemn the whole class.

James 3:1

(Additional passages: 1 Timothy 3:1; 1 Corinthians 9:16; Acts 20:26; 1 Timothy 1:3; Hebrews 13:17)

**Principle #1**: The more you give out God's Word, the greater is your responsibility to God Himself.

**Division 2:** Taming the power of the tongue benefits the whole body. James 3:2-12

(Additional passages: James 1:26; Romans 3:13; Psalm 39:1; Proverbs 26:21; Psalms 141:3; Mark 7:23)

**Principle #2**: A ready tongue without a transformed heart will hinder rather than advance the cause of Christ.

**Division 3:** Godly wisdom is from God, but worldly wisdom is from below. James 3:13-18

(Additional passages: Matthew 11:29; Proverbs 2:6; Proverbs 2:10)

**Principle #3**: Godly wisdom pursues friendship with God rather than the world, but worldly wisdom leads to destructive words and judgment.
