Divisions and Principles

Division 1: Rich oppressors will be judged for how they gained and used their wealth.

James 5:1-6

(Additional passages: Deuteronomy 8:18; Proverbs 10:22; 1 Timothy 6:17; Matthew 6:24; Matthew 6:21; 1 Timothy 6:10; Revelation 3:17; Psalm 49:20; Proverbs 23:4; Luke 6:23-24; Luke 12:18-21; Romans 2:5; Deuteronomy 24:15)

Principle #1: Our earthly wealth brings opportunities for good, but a frightening eternal judgment for greed and misuse.

Division 2: Oppressed Believers are to patiently prepare for Jesus' return and for His wedding feast.

James 5:7-12

(Additional passages: Matthew 24:30; Revelation 19:9; Luke 22:20; 1 Peter 4:8; Revelation 19:7)

Principle #2: We are to patiently wait for Jesus' return by remaining pure, no matter how long it takes or the trouble we face.

Division 3: The prayer of faith can save a soul from death. James 5:13-20

(Additional passages: 1 Thessalonians 5:17; Titus 1:9)

Principle #3: Our continual prayers and loving actions will help to restore God's battered and wandering sheep.
