Nehemiah 7:1 - 8:18: "Reading God's Word"

DIVISIONS AND PRINCIPLES

Division 1:

Nehemiah appoints people and takes precautions to protect Jerusalem. Nehemiah 7; Hebrews 9:10; Colossians 2:16-17; Deuteronomy 16:16; 2 Chronicles 7:1-16; John 4:21-24; 1 John 4:1-6

Principle #1: In order to worship in Spirit and Truth, we must guard the gates to our minds and appoint qualified spiritual leaders to protect us.

Division 2:

Ezra reads God's Word and the people understand it and mourn.

Nehemiah 8:1-9; James 1:5; 1 Corinthians 2:14; 1 Corinthians 3:1; Ephesians 1:13; Galatians 3:2; Acts 8:14; Romans 8:9-11; Hebrews 5:11-14; Ezekiel 36:27

Principle #2: By believing the milk of the Gospel, we receive God's Spirit, who then gives us a burning desire to obey God's Word and through obedience, we can then learn deeper truths.

Division 3:

Nehemiah declares the day of understanding, sacred, and one of Joy. Nehemiah 8:10-18; Romans 3:20; Leviticus 16:30

Principle #3: Understanding God's Word brings great joy when it creates faith that our sins have been taken away.
