Division 1: Paul shows how God has not rejected His people.

Principle #1: *God elected to save only those people who obtain righteousness by faith; those people will never be rejected by the Father because they are His inheritance from the Son.*

Division 2: Paul reveals that God has partially hardened Israel.

Principle #2: *God partially hardened ethnic Israel in judgment by withholding Truth from Israel, because Israel refused to believe the Truth it had.*
