Principle #1^A: Human beings who carry out the tasks God has assigned them are never to be seen as anything but God's servants.

Principle #1^B: God will eternally reward his servants for the effectiveness of their service for Him while on Earth.

Principle #2^A: Believers who effectively teach others the real Word of God will be rewarded with greater responsibility and Christ's happiness in eternity, but those who don't will have no such rewards.

Principle #2^B: Professing Christians, who use human authorities for their discipling of others, risk their own salvation and the salvation of all who follow them.
