Division 1: The Servant takes an oath and accepts a critical, godly mission.

Genesis 24:1-9

Matthew 23:12 "Whoever exalts himself shall be humbled; and whoever humbles himself shall be exalted."

Psalm 37:5 Commit your way to the LORD, Trust also in Him, and He will do it.

Psalm 115:10-11 O' house of Aaron, trust in the LORD; He is their help and their shield. You who fear the LORD, trust in the LORD; He is their help and their shield.

Psalm 91:11 For He will give His angels charge concerning you, To guard you in all your ways.

Hebrews 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits, sent out to render service for the sake of those who will inherit salvation?

Principle #1: A Godly servant faithfully obeys God's Word and trusts His promises will be fulfilled.
