Introduction

Co-incidence? No. GOD-incidence! Yes.

James 2:17b (NIV) "... faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead."

Revelation 4:8b (NIV) "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty,' who was, and is, and is to come!"

Genesis 39:21 (ESV) "But the Lord was with Joseph and showed him steadfast love and gave him favor . . ."

Genesis 37:7 (ESV) "Behold, we were binding sheaves in the field, and behold, my sheaf arose and stood upright. And behold, your sheaves gathered around it and bowed down to my sheaf."

Genesis 37:9 (ESV) "Then he dreamed another dream and told it to his brothers and said, "Behold, I have dreamed another dream. Behold, the sun, the moon, and eleven stars were bowing down to me."'

1 Corinthians 1:19 (NIV) "For it is written: 'I will destroy the wisdom of the wise; the intelligence of the intelligent I will frustrate.' "

Genesis 40:5 (ESV) "And one night they both dreamed — the cupbearer and the baker of the king of Egypt, who were confined in the prison — each his own dream, and each dream with its own interpretation."

Genesis 40:8 (ESV) "We have had dreams, and there is no one to interpret them." And Joseph said to them, "Do not interpretations belong to God? Please tell them to me."

Genesis 40:9 (ESV) "So, the chief cupbearer told his dream to Joseph . . ."

Genesis 40:16 (ESV) "When the chief baker saw that the interpretation was favorable, he said to Joseph, "I also had a dream . . ."

Division 1: God was with Joseph, the imprisoned slave, and through many God-incidences, the dreams Joseph interpreted, were fulfilled.

Genesis 41:1-36

Principle #1: God has woven together an intricate plan and begins to execute it through His servant Joseph.

James 1:23 (NIV) Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.

James 1:24 (NIV) Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror

James 1:25 (NIV) and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like."

Philippians 4:6 (NIV) "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God."
